Description

The Dr. Jean L. Harris Two-Year Scholarship honors the legacy of former Eden Prairie Mayor Dr. Jean L. Harris and her lifelong commitment to diversity, inclusion, and human rights. This scholarship recognizes a graduating senior who is a resident of Eden Prairie. The student's community involvement must reflect the values expressed in the Eden Prairie Manifesto.

Criteria

- Be a resident of the city of Eden Prairie graduating in 2026.
- Plan to attend a post-secondary institution (2-year program)
- Demonstrate involvement reflecting leadership, service, diversity, inclusion, and human rights values

Procedure

- Applications are **due April 15th, 2026** via Email to Emily Orr, emilyorr@epcommunityfoundation.org.
- Along with your application, please **Submit two letters of recommendation** and a **school transcript**.
- A committee will select the recipient. The scholarship will be awarded in late May
