2025 Impact REPORT

Dear Friends of the Foundation,

When I joined this Foundation in February, I walked into something already in motion, a community that had been quietly, generously, and consistently showing up for one another. What I found was not a Foundation waiting to make an impact. It was one already making it, every single day, because of supporters like you.

I am proud to share that the fiscal year July 2024–June 2025 was another record year in grantmaking for the Eden Prairie Community Foundation. That milestone belongs to this community; To the donors, volunteers, nonprofit partners, and neighbors who make Eden Prairie a place where all who live and work here can truly flourish.

This year, your generosity reached people where they needed it most. Families found food security through PROP, Every Meal, and Good in the 'Hood. Survivors of domestic violence found safety and advocacy through Sojourner Project and Maria's Voice. Young people discovered their potential through programs like Kaleidoscope Teens' Teen Voices Book Project and youth leadership training at the New American Development Center. Seniors stayed in their homes with support from Senior Community Services, and individuals with disabilities gained access to music therapy, adaptive recreation, and community connection. Our community itself grew stronger through investments in local journalism, park stewardship, and the arts.

Impact is more than a dollar figure. It is a teenager holding a book she wrote. It is a senior staying in the home she loves. It is a family that made it through a hard season because help and support were there. You will find two of these stories inside this annual report, and throughout the year we will be sharing more through nonprofit spotlights in our monthly eNewsletter and on social media. If you aren't already subscribed, we'd love to have you join! We recently launched a new CRM with updated email offerings, and it's a great way to stay connected to the work you make possible.

I am grateful to have joined a team that is talented, passionate, and deeply committed to this community. This record year belongs to all of us, and I can't wait to see what we build together next.

IMPACT GRANT SPOTLIGHT:

YMCA OF THE NORTH



YMCA of the North strives to be community-centered, bring people together, nurture potential, and maintain a local presence. They accomplish this mission through numerous programs including the **Neighborhood Centers program at Briarhill Apartments** right here in Eden Prairie. This program connects young people to caring adults, friends, and support systems.

The **Neighborhood Center** is a safe space where youth thrive academically, socially, and emotionally and delivers programming to youth after school, on school release days, and during summer break.

During the 2025 holiday season, the **Neighborhood Center** became a place of celebration, connection, and relief for families who were carrying heavy financial stress. Through meaningful partnerships, every registered youth at our **Neighborhood Center** was able to receive two to three holiday gifts, helping to ease the pressure many caregivers felt during an already challenging time of year.

Families came together for holiday parties that created a sense of belonging and joy. The atmosphere was filled with excitement as children participated in activities and built memories that extended beyond the holiday season.



One parent shared that attending the holiday party made them feel supported and remembered during a difficult season in their life. For many families, the **Neighborhood Centers** didn't just provide gifts, they provided hope, dignity, and reassurance that their community sees them, cares for them, and stands alongside them when it matters most.

IMPACT GRANTS BY THE NUMBERS

We receive numerous applications from community groups and students each year. In 2025, we were able to provide **26 grants & 9 scholarships** through our competitive grantmaking process.

2025 has been our biggest year to date for grantmaking, and we couldn't have done it without your support.

Impact Grants are used to fund various charitable projects all throughout the community. Because we support such a wide range of organizations, chances are that every EP resident has felt the effects of our programs, whether they realize it or not!

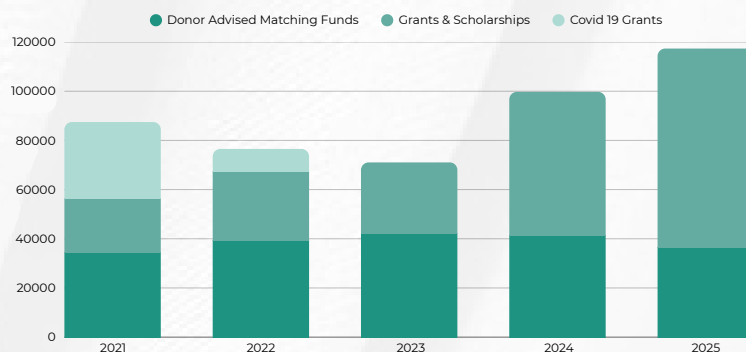

EXPENSES & REVENUE

We work hard to be a fiscally responsible organization with the greatest possible impact on the community. The majority of our revenue is spent on community-focused initiatives, including grant-making for local organizations and events that bring our neighbors together.

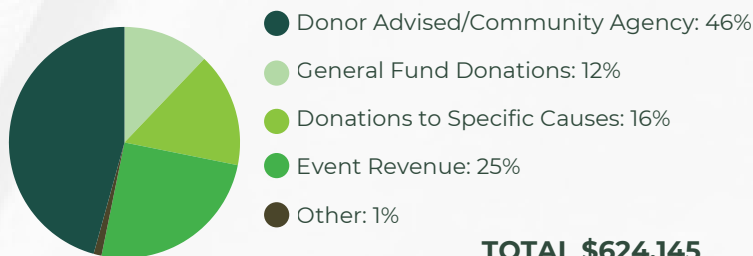
65% of our expenses went to community support in the form of grants, scholarships, and other initiatives that directly impact the community. Another 12% went towards events such as Prairie Brewfest and our EP Gives Gala, which are wonderful events for neighbors to connect and raise money for community causes.

IMPACT GRANT SPOTLIGHT: HELPING PAWS



Helping Paws exists to further people's independence and quality of life through the use of assistance dogs.

This goal is accomplished through a few programs including dog breeding, assistance dog training, graduate placement and more.

Helping Paws serves veterans, first responders, and individuals with physical disabilities and are located within Eden Prairie, serving members of its community.

This year, Helping Paws provided ongoing follow-up care for 23 assistance dog teams. This ensures long-term success, stability and responsiveness to evolving client needs. HP successfully placed 14 assistance dogs, supported 48 dogs in active training and delivered 100+ structured training classes. Additionally, 10-12 puppies participate weekly in the Herman Puppy Enrichment Center, building skills for long term success.

One example of Helping Paws impact is graduate Jack and his service dog, Zara. Jack's medical conditions affect fine motor control and daily functioning, making detailed woodworking difficult and sometimes unsafe. With Zara's assistance, particularly retrieving dropped tools, Jack regained the ability to work independently and safely.

Jack credits Zara and HP's training with enabling him to operate Carlos Family Woodworks and become a small business owner selling his goods at local events.
